offers educational opportunities in
the following areas;**

In Class Education

Through the National Fire Protection Association, we can offer the courses described below. There would be a cost for classroom materials and a time commitment that would need to be built into your semester.

Learn not to Burn– Ages Pre-K— Grade 3.

This fire safety program is taught in the regular school curriculum by the teacher. Topics include; Stop, Drop and Roll, exit drills in the home, burn safety and home hazards. Time allowance– 8 weeks

Risk Watch– Ages—K- Grade 8

This is an interactive program that teaches children Fire and Accident Prevention. Time allowance– 8 weeks

Middle School Mix - Grades 6-8

This amazing opportunity brings firefighters in the classroom to teach life skills that are proven to save lives and property.

Grade 6— Use of fire extinguisher

Grade 7— Home safety education

Grade 8—First Aid and CPR

There will be a fee for each class which could be added to the school fees paid each year.

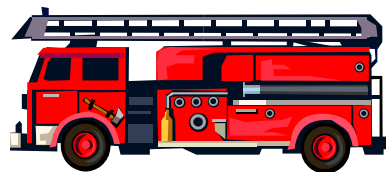
Fire Safety House– This is an actual house that we'll bring to your location. The children take a tour of the living room, kitchen and bedroom learning about fire safety for every room in the house. Time allowance– 15 minutes per group of 10-15. Target audience– Kindergarten– 4th grade.

Fire Truck Tours– Just like it sounds. The participants will get an up close look at what equipment fire-fighters use every day during an emergency. Time allowance– 20 minutes. Target audience– PreK– Adult

Firefighter in Turnout Gear– This is an excellent demonstration for small children. Piece by piece, a firefighter will put on his coat, pants, helmet, and breathing apparatus. This is a great way to alleviate a child's fear of firefighters. Time allowance– 10 minutes. Target audience– PreK– 3rd grade.

Station Tours– Come to the fire station and see where the firefighters eat, sleep and work. The tour of the station is fun and informative for kids of all ages. Time– 30 minutes. Target audience– PreK– Adult

Firefighter Story Time– Would you like a special guest to come and read to your class or group? We are happy to provide this service. Target audience– PreK– 2nd grade. Time– 15 minutes



Community Resources

First Aid/CPR– This class will give you the skills necessary to help save a life. This class will teach you basic first aid and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation. There is a nominal fee for this class and it is only held once a month. Target audience– 14– Adult. Time 2-4 hours

Block parties— Have the firefighters come to your block party! We are happy to come out and talk to you, show off the equipment and maybe even let the kids squirt some water! This must be scheduled at least 1 week in advance with the understanding that we may be called away, late or even unable to show up because we are handling an emergency.

Remembering When– A special presentation geared towards teaching the elderly and/or caregivers about fire safety and fall prevention. Time allowance– 45 minutes. Target audience– Age 50+ and./ or their caregivers
