

SIGNAL 23 CALL BACK

Purpose:

In the event that the district encounters a large or full scale emergency, it may be necessary to have some or all full-time employees return to work on their off days or off time.

Administration:

- A. When the Incident Commander deems it necessary to have additional employees on the scene, the Incident Commander shall have PSCC dispatch a "Signal 23" by utilizing the fire tones for Burlington.
- B. Personnel at the station shall use the email paging system to notify personnel that have Nextel phones.
- C. This alert tone will notify all full-time employees off duty to report back to work.
- D. All off duty full-time employees reporting back to work shall report to the fire station and contact the Incident Commander for assignment.
- E. The Incident Commander shall be the only person requesting such a call back.
- F. All off duty full-time employees reporting back to work shall be compensated at a minimum of two hours pay at 1 ½ times the normal hourly pay.
- G. Hours worked after that will be at the Regular Full Time Shift Employee unscheduled overtime rate and 40 RFTE overtime rate.
