

**REIMBURSEMENT POLICY**

The district has established a fee schedule for services rendered to recover expenses incurred for personnel, materials, apparatus, and any other expenses the district may encounter. The district has a legal and moral obligation to the area in which it serves, however, when an accident occurs involving individuals and/or companies traveling through district boundaries, those individuals or companies shall reimburse the district for operating expenses. The Reimbursement Policy is divided into two categories. Standard Services and Hazardous Material Services. Standard services are usually billed by the district, hazardous materials incidents are billed by Boone County Emergency Management.

- PSCC WILL BE BILLED FOR ON A PERCENTILE BASIS
- CLEANUP, DISPOSAL, TOWING AND ANY OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RESOURCE SHALL BE INVOICED AT ACTUAL COST.
