
CIVIL RIGHTS REASONABLE ACCOMODATIONS

It is the policy of Burlington Fire Protection District not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability. In an effort to ensure the public served, including persons with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) and persons with disabilities, has access to the services and programs of the district, the Burlington Fire Protection District will take reasonable steps to ensure access to all people and that accommodation is available to facilitate the participation of those persons with English language proficiency and/or disability.

Burlington Fire Protection District provides, at no cost, appropriate auxiliary aids and services including qualified interpreters to LEP persons, to disabled persons who are deaf or hard of hearing, and other individuals as necessary to ensure effective communication or an equal opportunity to participate fully in the decision-making process.

To access a reasonable accommodation, any person may make a request in writing to the Burlington Fire Protection District's Civil Rights Coordinator, Fire Chief Jeff Barlow, or succeeding Fire Chief, 6050 Firehouse Drive, Burlington, Kentucky 41005, (859) 586-6161, or fax 859-586-6178, or e-mail jbarlow@burlingtonkyfire.org, with details specifying what accommodation is sought as well as any pertinent information the requestor can provide to be considered by the District in arranging such accommodation. The district will make reasonable efforts to fulfill requests to maintain equal access for all persons seeking programs and services from the Burlington Fire Protection District. A response to request(s) received by the Burlington Fire Protection District will be provided within 60 days, and as soon as possible.
